The Kanga Cup is one of the biggest youth football tournaments in the southern hemisphere. 2009 saw 230 teams take part in the week long tournament. Referees from all over Australia and NZ aged from 15—23 years old are encouraged to submit their application for this prestigious youth tournament.

We are pleased to announce this year's tournament will have a newly devised Referee development program, which will provide a intensive live in experience for referees including seminars with FIFA, AFC and Hyundai A-League Referees, one on one coaching sessions with Referee coaches and an opportunity to learn from other referees and make lifelong friends. Capital Football is also working on bringing an international referee/ coach to work with the tournament referees. For the first time ten local referees will be invited to live in during the tournament and share the experience with their interstate colleagues.
