1. Introduction and Competition Overview

Capital Football is introducing a brand new junior futsal competition for the upcoming summer season, the 2011/12 Futsal Junior Premier League (FJPL). The FJPL is a new initiative which aims to:

- Provide a higher standard of games for junior participants (players, coaches and referees)
- Reward good performances in club competitions
- Improve player development pathways to allow players to transition from recreational to elite club-based futsal
- Develop the base of players other than representative players

The FJPL will kick off on 7th November 2011, and finish in March 2012, with a break over Christmas and January. The competition will take place on a Monday night to avoid conflict with existing junior futsal competitions.

The 2011/12 Junior Futsal Premier League will require clubs to nominate for entry and meet criteria that ensures teams competing in the league are of the highest standard possible. The criteria sets minimum club, team, coaching and administration standards that will over time help increase the overall quality of the league.

2. FJPL Criteria

Team nominations must be submitted in line with the following criteria.

1. Club status and player registrations

- Nominating Club must be an affiliate of Capital Football.
- Nominating Clubs must submit at least 1 team for each of the divisions on offer: Boys U12 and Girls U12.
- Players nominated must be registered for the club; and playing domestically in a Capital Football sanctioned competition.
- Team applications should be made by the Club committees after holding their own relevant trials or equivalent selection process.
- All players must play in their correct age group.

2. Futsal Development

- Clubs to appoint suitably qualified Coaches for all teams (Minimum Level 1/Certificate Level qualification).
 - Details of coaches required with application.

3. Administration, Conduct & Financial guarantee

The Club can demonstrate that it has the capacity for effective administrative and game day management of its team by:

- Lodgement of all player registration fees with application by the cut-off date.

- b. Agree to abide with CF in regard to rules, codes of conduct, uniform standards and other requirements pertaining to Clubs/Teams and players
 - o Agreement supplied with application.

4. Marketing & Media Relations

The Club demonstrates a capacity for a commitment to enhancing the positive image of Futsal within the local community and the ACT by:

- a. Working with the CF Media Officer
 - o The Club Delegate is to act as a media liaison. Contact details required with application.
- b. Internal Club Promotion
 - o Provide details of internal club promotion of Junior Futsal Premier League
- c. Each team must also provide a team delegate / manager who will be contacted by Capital Football in regards to draw, venue changes and any other competition concerns. The team delegate must ensure that all relevant information regarding the competition is passed onto other members of the team. Please note that the preferred form of communication is via email.

3. Fees

The fee structure (per player) for the 2011/12 Futsal Junior Premier League is as follows:

1. Under 12 Boys and Girls	\$80-
Additions:	
1. Insurance (for non-CF registered players)	\$11
2. Capitation fee (for non-SCF/NCF registered players)	\$44

Fees take into account: venue hire, referee fees, registration, administration and trophies.

4. Playing Conditions and Disciplinary Regulations

Playing conditions governing the 2011/12 FJPL will be available on our website prior to the commencement of the competition.

5. Registration

Registration for the 2011/12 FJPL will be done online via MyFootballClub. The full registration process is outlined below.

Registration Process

- **Step 1 –** Team Manager to complete Application addressing the FJPL Criteria and attach Team Nomination Form (see page 7).
- **Step 2 –** Team Manager to ensure all players individually register on My Football Club. This process is similar to registering for a club for an outdoor competition. Follow these steps to complete your individual registration:
 1. Go to <http://www.myfootballclub.com.au/default.aspx> and click on '2011 Registration'. Under Registration Links, click on 2011 Player Registration.
 2. Follow the prompts to find your FFA number (if unknown), and log in using your FFA number and password. If you don't have an FFA number, or if the system fails to find your number, follow the links to create one and log in using your new number.
 3. Click on 'Register now'. Check that all your details are correct and click 'Proceed with registration'.
 4. Under club, search for and select 'Capital Futsal (Club)'. Under registration, select 'Player'. Under registration package, select the fee package applicable to you (see Fees section above for details). For example, a player who is registered in a NCF/SCF/Boomerangs Junior Futsal competition in season 2011/12 should select 'FJPL 2011/12 (existing player)'.
 5. Follow the prompts to complete your registration. When you arrive at the payment screen, select 'Invoice me'. Hand this invoice with your payment to your team manager.
- **Step 3 –** Team Manager to collect all individual player registration fees, and submit the complete team payment with Team Application.

Team payments can be made by –

- e) In person – Capital Football Office, Unit 2/3 Phipps Close Deakin (for cash, credit, EFTPOS and cheque payments).

6. Insurance Information

Capital Football carries sports injury insurance with Sportscover Insurance Ltd through Marsh Insurance Australia Pty Ltd for registered members. To be a registered member of Capital Football a participant must have completed and lodged an individual registration form with Capital Football or their affiliate club.

Capital Football encourages all players to take out Private Health Cover.
