Notes for Filling out the Referee Evaluation Form

1. Wait at least one hour after the match to complete the evaluation form.
2. If possible get the same person each week to fill out the form.
3. Choose a responsible club member who attended the game to complete the form.
4. It should not be the coach of the team competing that completes the form.
5. It is compulsory for all Premier League, Premier Pathway League and Premier League 18. For all other divisions it is optional.
6. This form must be returned via fax, emailed or posted to Capital Football by 4:30pm on the first Wednesday following the weekends match.
7. If it is not returned by the specified date a \$20 fine will be imposed on the club. It is a maximum of \$20 per week ie so if a club forgets to fill out PL, PLR and PL18 one week the maximum fine for that week is \$20.
8. This evaluation form is not to be discussed or shared with any referees.

Note: This evaluation sheet is to benefit the sport in the ACT. Clubs should use this as a constructive tool to give feedback regarding the referee.
